**CONVENE:** Mayor Mary Ann Lutz convened the Regular Meeting of the Monrovia City Council of Tuesday, April 21, 2015, at 7:30 p.m. in City Council Chambers. In attendance were City Manager Oliver Chi, Acting City Attorney Roxanne Diaz, and City Clerk Alice D. Atkins.

Mayor Lutz consented to designating Councilmembers Spicer and Blackburn to the subcommittee.


