TITLE Urban Water Management Plan Update, Resolution No 2006-09

OBJECTIVE To approve Resolution No 2006-09 adopting the 2005 Urban Water Management Plan

BACKGROUND In accordance with the California Urban Water Management Plan Act of 1990 an Urban Water Management Plan must be prepared by each urban water supplier that provides water for municipal services to more than 3,000 customers or more than 3,000 acre-fee of water annually The Plan must be updated every five (5) years

This plan assures that the City's water system is in compliance with the State of California Department of Water Resources Urban Water Management Plan under Water Code Section 10620 The Utility Division must review its plan and make amendments and changes as they pertain to the City's water system

ANALYSIS The following issues are addressed in the Plan

- Description of the city water facilities and service area
- Existing available water supplies
- Reliability of water supplies
- Opportunities for exchanges or transfers of water
- Projected water use past and current
- Description of Best Management Practices (BMP) and their implementation
- Urban water shortage contingency analysis
- Information on recycled water and its potential use

After adoption of the resolution by City Council the plan will be filed with the City Clerk's Office and with the State Department of Water Resources

RESOLUTION NO 2006-09

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MONROVIA, CALIFORNIA, TO ADOPT
THE URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROVIA, CALIFORNIA, DOES
HEREBY DETERMINE, FIND AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS**

WHEREAS, the California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 797 (Water Code Section 10610 et seq , known as the Urban Water Management Planning Act) during the 1983-84 Regular Session, and as amended subsequently, which mandates that every supplier providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre feet of water annually, prepare an urban Water Management Plan, the primary objective of which is to plan for the conservation and efficient use of water, and

WHEREAS, the City is an urban supplier of water providing water to over 9,000 customers, and

WHEREAS, the Plan shall be periodically reviewed at least once every five years, and that the City shall make any amendments or changes to its plan which are indicated by the review, and

WHEREAS, the City has therefore, prepared and circulated for public review an Urban Water Management Plan, and a properly noticed public hearing regarding said Plan was held by the City of Monrovia on March 21, 2006, and

WHEREAS, the City of Monrovia did prepare and shall file said Plan with the California Department of Water Resources by December 2006

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MONROVIA, CALIFORNIA DOES FIND, RESOLVE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS**

Section 1 The 2005 Urban Water Management Plan is hereby adopted and ordered filed with the City Clerk,

Section 2 The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to file the 2005 Urban Water Management Plan with the California Department of Water Resources within 30 days after this date,

Section 3 The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to implement the Water Conservation Programs as set forth in the 2005 Urban Water Management Plan, which includes water shortage contingency analysis and recommendations to the City Council regarding necessary procedures, rules, and regulations to carry out effective and equitable water conservation and water recycling programs,

Section 4 In a water shortage, the Mayor is hereby authorized to declare a Water Shortage Emergency according to the Water Shortage Stages and Triggers indicated in the Plan, and implement necessary elements of the Plan, and

Section 5 The Mayor shall recommend to the City Council additional procedures, rules, and regulations to carry out effective and equitable allocation of water resources
