Mayor Hammond called for a recess from 4 08 P.M. to 4:20 P.M.


CITY COUNCIL PRIORITIES FOR FISCAL YEARS 2007-2009: It was moved by Mayor Hammond, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Kirby, to continue with the existing Council Priorities through fiscal years 2007-2009. The Council Priorities were on file in the Office of the City Clerk. There were no objections

Administrative Services Director Mark Alvarado reviewed the proposed Fees and Charges. Administrative Services Director Alvarado noted that the City Council was presented with a revised report of the proposed Fees and Charges, which included the two columns requested at the prior Study Session to indicate the percentage of the increase as well as the percentage of cost recovery increase. Discussion ensued regarding particular fee increases, how cost recovery figures were calculated, customer service standards, and quality of life services versus necessary services City Manager Ochoa stated that Staff could provide a sampling of MSI Study worksheets to give a better idea of how cost recovery was calculated

PUBLIC INPUT: There was none.


ADJOURNMENT: Mayor Hammond adjourned the Meeting at 5:12 P M.
