TITLE Award of Contract to California Surfacing for the Recreation Park Improvement, Tennis Court Resurfacing, Project No C-3019, in the Amount of \$28,800 00

OBJECTIVE To resurface the Recreation Park Tennis Courts with a plexipave surface coating

BACKGROUND The remaining State Proposition 40 funds will be used to resurface the Recreation Park Tennis Courts with a plexipave playing surface. These park improvements are listed as part of the Park Capital Projects List.

ANALYSIS Bids for the Recreation Park Improvement, Resurfacing were opened by the City Clerk's Office on December 22, 2008. Two (2) bids were received ranging from \$28,800 00 to \$29,600 00.

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| 1 | California Surfacing – Claremont, California | \$28,800 00 |
| 2 | Malibu Pacific Tennis Courts – West Lake Village, California | \$29,600 00 |

After evaluating each bid, checking references, insurance and licenses, California Surfacing appears to be the lowest qualified bidder, with excellent references. They have also completed this type of work for the City of Diamond Bar, Huntington Beach and San Dimas.

There was a slight irregularity in the California Surfacing's Bid. They did not recognize Addendum No. 1 detailing the type of contractor's license that would be required for the project. California Surfacing possesses a valid and current C61/D47 license necessary for the resurfacing work. Staff has discussed the irregularity with the City Attorney and has approved to move forward in awarding the contract.

FISCAL IMPACT Funding will come from State Proposition 40 funds, with an additional \$10,000 00 from the Capital Project Fund.

RECOMMENDATION Award of contract to California Surfacing, 4457 Oak Lane, Claremont, California 91711 in the amount of \$28,800 00 for the Recreation Park Improvement, Tennis Court Resurfacing, Project No C-3019.

ACTION REQUIRED If the City Council concurs, the appropriate action would be a motion to Award of Contract to California Surfacing for the Recreation Park Improvement, Tennis Court Resurfacing, Project No C-3019, in the Amount of \$28,800 00.

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
