**TITLE:** Denial of Liability Claim – Nathan Eli vs City of Monrovia

**OBJECTIVE:** To provide the basis for the City Council to take action related to this liability claim filed against the City

**BACKGROUND:** Mr Eli maintains that on October 20, 2003, Monrovia Police personnel and Code Enforcement personnel conducted a search of his property. He alleges that since that time he has been subject to harassment by Monrovia staff and been denied his civil rights.

**ANALYSIS:** After discussion with outside Counsel, it appears that City staff acted in an appropriate manner. Therefore, the City bears no responsibility in this matter.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Claimant is seeking approximately \$112,490 in damages.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends that Council deny this claim.

**COUNCIL ACTION REQUIRED:** If the City Council concurs, the appropriate action would be a motion to deny the claim filed by Nathan Eli against the City of Monrovia.
