TITLE Purchase of Interior Furnishings for the Youth and Adult Services Areas from Yamada Enterprises for the Monrovia Public Library in an Amount not to Exceed \$230,000

OBJECTIVE To purchase from Yamada Enterprises Interior Furnishings for the Youth and Adult Services Areas of the new Monrovia Public Library for the Amount not to Exceed \$230,000

BACKGROUND At the April 15, 2008 City Council meeting the City Council approved the Library Board's recommendations for the Interior furnishings for the Youth and Adult Services areas of the new Monrovia Public Library. The furnishings presented are represented by Yamada Enterprises. Yamada has over twenty-five years of experience with interior furnishings for public libraries.

ANALYSIS Selections for the Adult & Youth Services portions of the Library include furnishings for the various age groups served by Youth Services. The Adult section includes furnishings for the teen area, study rooms, computer workstations as well as study tables and quiet reading areas.

Yamada Enterprises are the sole source representatives in California for the TMC furniture selected for the Youth Services area.

The Worden furniture pricing is discounted through the State of California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS contract). This contract gives the City a 40 to 44% discount.

FISCAL IMPACT The fiscal impact is an amount not to exceed \$230,000. This will be paid out of the Library Building Project.

RECOMMENDATION Staff recommends the purchase of the Adult and Youth Services furnishings from Yamada Enterprises for the new Monrovia Public Library in an amount not to exceed \$230,000 as outlined in this report.

COUNCIL ACTION REQUIRED If the City Council concurs, the appropriate action would be a motion to approve the purchase of the Adult and Youth Services furnishings from Yamada Enterprises for the new Monrovia Public Library in the amount not to exceed \$230,000.

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
