TITLE: Letter From the City Clerk Transmitting Ordinance No. 2003-13, Adopting the Seventh Amendment to the Amended Redevelopment Plan for Project Area No 1, the Central Redevelopment Project.

OBJECTIVE: Pursuant to Section 33372 of the Community Redevelopment Law, the City Clerk is required to transmit the ordinance and adopted Seventh Amendment to the Redevelopment Agency 30 days after the ordinance has become effective.

BACKGROUND: On September 2, 2003, the City Council adopted Ordinance 2003-13, approving and adopting the Seventh Amendment to the Amended Redevelopment Plan. The second reading occurred on September 16, 2003, and the Ordinance became effective 30 days following this action.

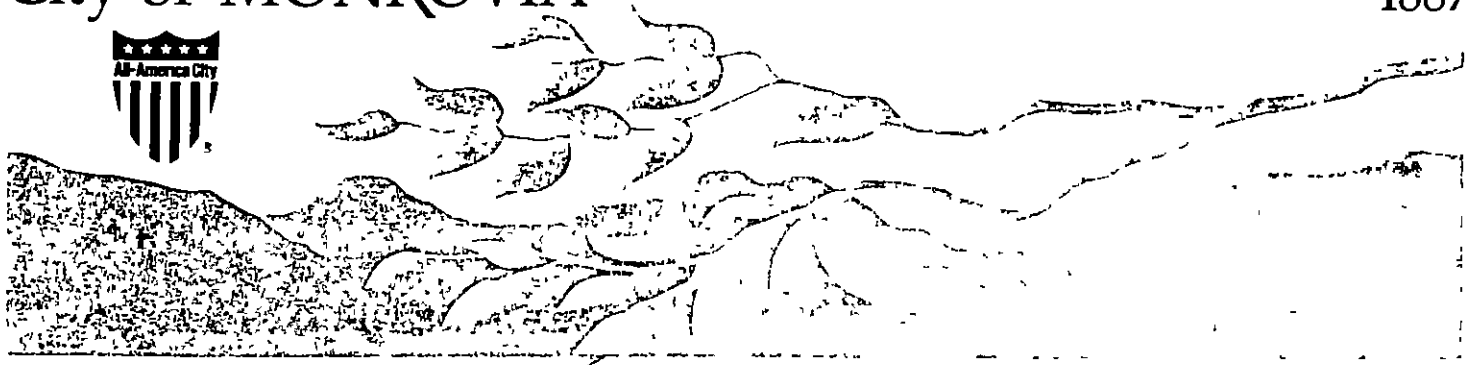
